

Francesco D. Busnelli (Fribourg,1935) is professor emeritus of Civil Law at School of Advanced Studies at University Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna in Pisa where he held the position of Chancellor from 1984 to 1993.

Full Professor of Law at University of Teramo from 1964 to 1971, at University of Pisa from 1971 to 1983 and from 1983 at Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna.

Honorary Professor at *Universidad San Marcos* in Lima.

Visiting Professor at *Yale Law School* in 1987 and in 1995, in 1993 he was in Belo Horizonte University (Brazil) and at University of Fribourg (Switzerland) in 2005.

He lectured on Civil Law in Bogotá, Buenos Aires, Burgos, Coimbra, Gottingen, Lyon, Paris 1, Beijing, Coimbra, San José de Costarica, Zaragoza, Stockholm and Tilburg.
